

# The Spirit of Aloha

Welcome to Puamana...

...we hope you have a wonderful visit. All the townhouses in Puamana are privately owned homes, please treat them with the same care you would your own home. More than half of the homes in Puamana are lived in by full time residents; many of the remaining units are available for rent when their owners aren't here. Everyone in Puamana, owners and guests alike, must follow the rules of the homeowners' association. In particular:

**QUIET HOURS** are 10 pm - 8 am. Please be especially courteous during these times by keeping noise to a minimum. Sound travels easily through the walls between units. Also, many people like to sleep with their windows open, so if you come home late from dinner or leave early for a sunrise trip be as quiet as you can. Everyone in Puamana is entitled to the quiet enjoyment of their home.

**OCEAN ACCESS** is in front of the 128 building, the 216 building and at the clubhouse. Never walk through the hedge to reach the beach; the plantings are there to hold our shore together.

**PARKING:** Park in the covered carport stall marked with your unit number, or in any uncovered stall. Never use a neighbor's assigned stall.

**RECREATION AREAS:** Please do not allow your children to play in front of your neighbors' homes. Puamana has designated recreation areas for activities such as ball playing, frisbee, soccer, football, and baseball: in front of the clubhouse by the tennis court and mango trees, at the mountain and dolphin pools, children's playground, tennis court and badminton court.

**THE KONA WINDS:** Strong winds always carry a tremendous amount of "Maui red dirt" from the sugar cane and pineapple fields. In an hour or two the dirt can coat tables, chairs, couches, dressers and beds. If the winds seem strong please keep your doors and windows closed.

**BBQ GRILLS:** When cooking outside please move the grill onto the lawn at least 4' away from your lanai so smoke doesn't go directly into neighboring homes. For safety reasons and because of the foul chemical smell liquid charcoal starters are discouraged in Puamana. Please purchase self-igniting charcoal.

**LANAI FURNITURE:** All furniture, BBQ grills, children's toys, kiddie pools and other items must be returned to your lanai each evening before dark.

**OUTDOOR LIGHTS:** Make sure your outdoor lights are turned off when you are not using them. Bright outside spotlights dim your neighbor's views of Maui's wonderful stars. However, if your unit has motion detector security lighting on the lanai be sure to leave it on at night. Lock up when you are away.

**MAUI FOOD BANK:** If you have any unopened nonperishable food you would like to donate to the local food bank when you checkout, please bring it to the Clubhouse and put it in the drop box next to the office window.
